

Counting over 250 members, we serve as a platform for debate, new care concepts, networking, and knowledge dissemination.

With health insurances, hospitals, research institutes, physician networks, as well as pharmaceutical, med-tech and IT companies amongst its members, the BMC represents the entire spectrum of players in health care. At the interface between politics, science and health care economy the BMC actively shapes the health policy discourse with events, policy papers, publications and a network of stakeholders.

Our members contribute with their interdisciplinary expertise in working groups and develop solutions for current and future challenges in health care. With around 650 participants, the annual BMC conference has a long-standing tradition of building bridges between innovative best practices, international experiences and research findings in order to connect important stakeholders from politics, science and industry. With its variety in topics, the conference has established itself as an essential event in the German health care landscape over the last years.

Moreover, the BMC organizes study trips each year in order to learn from best practices and innovations in health care systems of other countries and gather inspiration for shaping the future of the German health care system.

BMC CONFERENCE

The BMC conference is the platform for decision makers and practitioners of the health care system. The two-day conference takes place in January and assembles 150 international and national speakers as well as 600 health care experts.

SYMPOSIUMS

In order to provide a platform for innovative health care solutions and foster debate questions with regards to health system design, we organise small in-depth discussion rounds as well as larger symposiums.

BMC STUDY TRIPS

With the aim to gain insight and get inspired by international best practices, we organise study trips to other countries, such as Finland, Israel and the U.S. The diverse C-level participants from Germany and from our partner organization in Switzerland allow for profound debates and excellent networking opportunities.

WEBTALKS & SPOTLIGHTS

Online lectures, deep dive and best practices with regards to current health policy issues. With more than 2.000 participants in approx. 40 webtalks per year our members learn about innovations in health care and engage in discussions.

WORKING GOUPS

Our working groups engage in various health care fields such as integrated care, longterm care, future technology and value-based care. Meeting three to four times a year, our members creatively set their own targets, invite experts, develop new care concepts and write policy papers.

CAPITAL TALKS

The most exclusive of our formats is an intimate dinner at the Private Members Capital Club. We invite a high level speaker for a keynote and then discuss the topic with around 15 participants under the Chatham House Rule.

BROWN BAG

The BMC brown bag initiative brings together the future leaders of health care for networking and debate. Additionally to informal meetings, young professionals take part in site visits of health institutions, workshops as well as in international study trips. Furthermore, we organize an exclusive five-month networking program, the BMC Transformers, for a selected group of young professionals that are committed to driving innovation in health care.
